



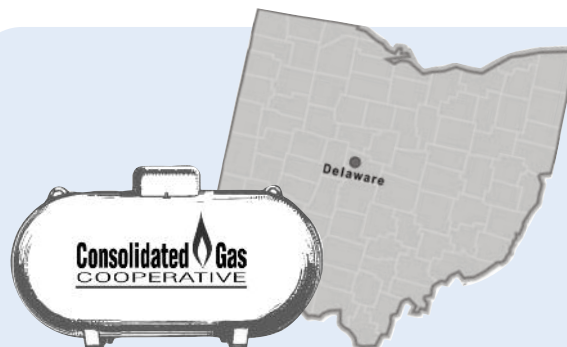

## Safe grilling tips

Before you grill, check all fittings to ensure there are no propane leaks. When the grill is cold, turn on the cylinder valve or gas and spray the connections with a leak-detection solution (a 50/50 mixture of water and liquid soap) to check for tightness. If bubbles appear then you have leaks so tighten the connections where the bubbling occurs.

- When lighting a grill, keep the top open until you are sure the grill is lit.
- Do not use matches or lighters to check for leaks.
- Do not allow children to tamper with the cylinder or grill.
- Do not smoke while handling a propane cylinder.
- When a grill is not in use, cover disconnected hose-end fittings with plastic bags or protective caps to keep clean.
- Always follow grill manufacturer's instructions and keep written materials accessible.
- Pour an accelerant such as lighter fluid or gasoline on the grill.
- Finished grilling, turn off the burner controls and close the cylinder valve.
